#### **ACCRA CITY TOUR**



Today marks the beginning of your cultural adventure in Accra. Following a relaxing breakfast, and a brief orientation on what to expect during your stay in Ghana, we depart for your Accra sightseeing

tour. From a distance, you can see **Ghana's Flagstaff House** where the president lives equivalent to **Downing Street** in the **UK**.

Enjoy a drive through tour of downtown Accra passing through the economic and administration districts visiting:

- . Ghana's Parliament
- . Accra Sports Stadium – you can view from the inside how spectacular the multi-use largest stadium in the country is.

- . **Independence Square** where you will see the enclosed flame of African liberation, which was lit by Dr. Kwame Nkrumah in 1961

After lunch, we continue tour with;

- . A visit to **Kwame Nkrumah Mausoleum and Museum**, a tribute to Ghana's first president. This part, formally called the Polo ground, is where Dr. Kwame Nkrumah declared the independence of Ghana.

- . **Accra Arts Market** — Here, you can purchase artifacts and clothes.

## KAKUM NATIONAL PARK | CAPE COAST CASTLE



Begin with a visit to Kakum National Park, home to lush rainforest and the famed canopy walkway.

In the afternoon, explore Cape Coast Castle and the poignant Point of No Return.

As night falls, experience the vibrant rhythms and energy of the city's nightlife and music.

After breakfast, we will visit the **Kakum National Park**, making a stop at the International Farm for Stingless Bees (Time Permitting). Kakum National Park has one of Africa's famous rainforest canopy walkways. This tropical rainforest and the canopy walkway are sure to be one of the highlights of your time in Ghana. The walkway consists of a series of 7 bridges, attached to 7 emerging trees, 40 meters above the rainforest floor. Prepare to take a deep breath as you walk the suspended bridges. You will marvel at the breathtaking views that stretch for miles across the rainforest as you rest on the tree platforms.

After lunch at the Hams Cottage, we visit the International Sting-less Bee Centre, where visitors can sample delicious honey and pollen and find out about this strange species (Time permitting)

In the afternoon we visit the **Cape Coast Castle and the Point of No Return**, which is one of the UNESCO World recognized forts and Castles in Ghana. The Cape Coast Castle houses the West African Historical Museum established by the Smithsonian Institute in collaboration with the Ghanaian Government in 1994. Cape Coast Castle is another restored UNESCO World Heritage Site. Here, you will embark on an intriguing, educative and informative guided tour of the facility. We continue to our resort in Elmina taking a scenic drive through the **University of Cape Coast**.

A full day dedicated to relaxation, reflection, and optional activities of your choosing.

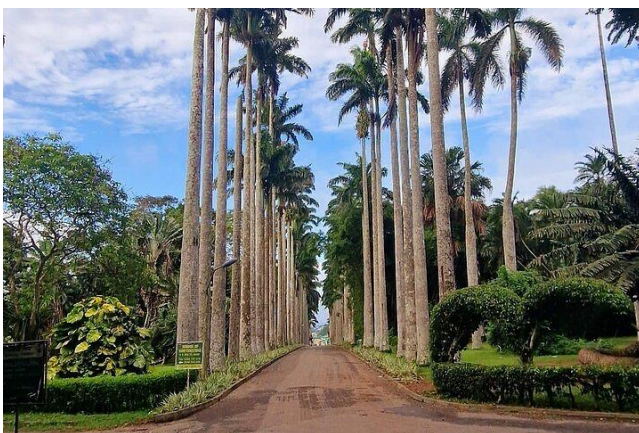
